

## MU LOCOS

Locos attached together are considered as multi-unit Locos (MU). In this section, user forms the MU Locos and splits the MU Locos as per the requirement.



*MU Locos Navigation Menu -*

### a. Add MU Locos:

Application allows the user to select two or more Locos to Add Multi Units (MU) Locos.

- Click on "MU Locos" side menu and select "Form MUs" sub menu.

- Click on  button to view the MU Locos details in the form of a tabular format.
